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## Auxey-Duresses 'Vieilles Vignes' 2023, Domaine Prunier-Bonheur

Produced from two parcels of vines, with an average age of 65 years old, that touch the appellation of Meursault. The combined 1.4ha lie on the top of the hill, and the vines are an average of 70 years old.

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### Tasting Notes:

Rich and honeyed bouquet, the theme continues on the palate with runny honey galore, nuts and butteriness. This wine has all the texture and weight and balance of a good Meursault. Outstanding value!

<b>Vinification</b>	The grapes are hand picked into small baskets and sorted at the winery. Fermentation is in tank at a low temperature, with 20% whole bunch fermentation. Spending 12 months in barrel, of which 20% is new, before a simple racking. Aged for a further 6 months in tank before bottling.
