Produced from two lieux-dits, Les Boutières and Préveaux, from vines averaging 60 years old and totalling 1.5 hectares, it is rare to find such concentration at this level.

Tasting Notes:

This is almost a New World style of Pinot and is hugely attractive. Sweet cherry and crunchy, fresh red fruit lead the way, supported by ripe, soft tannins and a fresh, balanced finish. Pure and expressive this is very stylish indeed!

The family has a lovely spread of top vineyards in Savigny-les-Beaune (both superb premier crus and a handful of top village wine parcels planted with very old pinot noir vines), as well as a bit of premier cru in Beaune and Pommard as well.
