A fabulous wine from Col di Lamo, one of the most dynamic and innovative emerging companies on the Tuscan scene. An exclusive, all-female company, owned by Giovanna Neri and her daughter Diletta, with a small production of absolute quality and refinement. The estate covers an area of approximately 80 hectares, of which 6 in Brunello di Montalcino, 1.5 in Rosso di Montalcino, and 2 hectares in native vines, and is located in one of the most evocative areas of Tuscany: between Montalcino and the rolling hills of the Val d'Orcia. The vineyards are located at an altitude of approximately 300 m above sea level and are managed organically.

"Soft bricky tone. This opens out spectacularly, flamboyantly ripe cherries with fruitcake accents, hugely powerful and exciting. Decant to show at its best. "...lovely and lively, with fragrant dark soil, sweet garden herbs and a bouquet of flowers greeting the nose.
