# Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Les Caillerets 2021, Domaine Amiot

The steeper slopes of Caillerets, strewn with lumps of limestone and pebbles, lie beside the winery on the southern aspect of the village, and this benefits from the afternoon sun. Amiot's 0.5ha is split between 2 parcels, one 85 years old, the other a mere 47!

### Tasting Notes:

The nose is incredibly rich, almost brooding, and the palate mirrors this rich intensity, offering peach, cashew, grapefruit and mineral notes, the power evident in each sip. The oak is subtle, hidden amongst the tight acidity and structure of what is a powerful and complex wine and the finish very long, with subtle hint of clove, minerals, cereal and intense citrus.
