Another Rothschild property produced by the team that makes Lafite, this 46-hectare estate is ever increasing its reputation for excellent, consistent quality, producing great wines over recent vintages.

Tasting Notes:

In 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon plays a dominant part in the blend. The bouquet is fully of blueberry freshness with alluring notes of pencil and cigar. The palate is fresh, very much a classic style of claret, with a leafy blackcurrant fruit, tightly knit tannins and a cool streak of graphite. The oak is fine and in check with appealing cedar notes on the finish.
