The grapes come from 100 plots around the 5 sub regions of Pouilly, taking advantage of the slate and sandy soils of Fuissé blended with the heavier clay and marl soils of Vergisson, to make a wonderfully complex and polished style of Pouilly Fuissé.

Tasting Notes:

The nose of Conference pear is immediately striking, followed by lush peach, apricot and apple fruit, bound with creamy oak and rapier-like acidity. There is tension in the wine and the finish is long.
