Now under the same ownership as Chateau Cantemerle in the Haut Medoc, this is a prestigious St Emilion Grand Cru Classe that has benefitted from investment and expertise from the new owners. Situated on the northwestern edge of Saint-Émilion, the estate's vineyards are planted predominantly with Merlot, complemented by Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon. The wines are known for their elegant structure, ripe dark fruit character, and refined tannins, balancing richness with freshness and precision. Careful vineyard management and modernised cellar practices have elevated both consistency and quality in recent vintages. Château Grand Corbin today offers a polished, age worthy expression of Right Bank Bordeaux that combines classic terroir character with contemporary finesse.

Tasting Notes:

In 2025 Grand Corbin made a wonderfully judged wine with the dominant Merlot component and smaller yields of just 30 hl/ha giving a restrained, elegant, and yet opulent style. Succulent red and black cherry fruit, laced with dark chocolate, coffee and baked plum. The tannins are held in check by the ripe fruit, a benefit of the blue clay soil. The result is a muscular yet rounded and approachable wine with real breeding and complexity.

Producer Overview	<p>Château Grand Corbin enjoys an enviable position on the north western plateau of Saint-Émilion, close to the border with Pomerol where its gravel and clay soils consistently produce wines of richness, charm and balance. This long established estate has been a fixture of the appellation for centuries and today remains one of the most reliable Grand Cru names, combining traditional Right Bank character with increasing refinement in the cellar. The vineyard is planted predominantly with Merlot, along with Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon, varieties ideally suited to the terroir and responsible for the wine's supple texture, dark fruit depth and elegant structure.
