Situated in the Haut-Médoc near Château Citran, Margaux, this sturdy petit-château claret is made from old vines, which grow on gravelly soil, and whose grapes are harvested by hand.

Tasting Notes:

Olivier Dumora uses 1 and 2 year old barrels from Château Prieure-Lichine for the élevage of this wine that punches hard and is a great entry into the Haut-Médoc appellation. The bouquet offers a fabulous rich and raisined black fruit aroma with an overt freshness. The mouthfeel is dense with a crunchy black fruit compote and juicy balance, firm but yielding tannins and a touch of sandalwood on the finish. This wine offers supreme value.
