The exposure of this property is ideal. This superb 4.6 hectare estate lies just in front of the chapel, only 200 metres from Vieux Château Certan and 300 metres from Château Pétrus. Clos de Clocher benefits from soils rich in blue clay. The 2024 is a special year for the château as it celebrates 100 years since Jean-Baptiste Bourotte's father purchased the first plot in front of the church. It is also the château's first officially certified organic vintage.

### Tasting Notes:

The wine is deeply coloured, almost inky, with an intense bouquet of ripe black cherry, blackberry, violet, chocolate and spice. The palate is stylish, with plush, round tannins and layers of sweet ripe black cherry and mocha. The tannins are finely grained, especially on the finish, offering excellent support to the ripe fruit and well-integrated oak. The wine remains fresh and vibrant throughout.
