Produced from a 0.5 hectare plot of vines planted very close to the village of Meursault with an average age of 70 years. Undoubtedly one of the best value white wines in this offer. Don't miss this one!!

Tasting Notes:

A mini Meursault, overt and aromatic, pure and precise, there is a wonderful streak of minerality that balances the ripe tropical fruit structure. Tasted blind, you would believe this wine is from a far higher appellation than mere Coteaux Bourguignon.
