### **Tasting Notes:**

The color is pale yellow with green highlights. A very expressive nose, marked by the mixture of white-skinned fruits, such as peach and notes of exotic fruits such as mango and citrus. On the palate, its vivacity on the attack and its balance completes a good minerality supported by notes of exotic fruits then an ample and long finish.
