There, it uses mostly indigenous grape varieties such as Roditis, Lagorthi, Sideritis, Mavro Kalavrytino, and Mavrodaphne, as well as international varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc. The winery has state-of-the-art winemaking equipment, two modern wine bottling lines and fully air-conditioned warehouses for preserving and ageing the wines. Their main goal and vision is to promote Greek vineyards both in Greece and abroad and are committed to producing high-quality wines.
