This is one of the most highly regarded 1er Crus, situated to the south of the village where the soil is poor with high mineral content. Michelot owns just 0.77 hectares in a single plot.

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### Tasting Notes:

Ripe, expressive and generous on the nose with Canteloup melon, Braeburn apple, pineapple, and honey, all laced with thrilling quenching acidity, intense minerality, and notes of vanilla. This is a very impressive, richly textured and powerful wine, yet the overall feeling is of a wine that has complexity and finesse throughout. Quite outstanding!
