## Meursault Village 2024, Domaine Michelot 6 x 75cl

Assembled from 7 different plots, totalling 7 hectares, which form 3 distinct cuvées, subsequently blended after fermentation, all with differing soils, microclimate and aspect. This wine is enriched by grapes produced from the lieux-dits vineyards of Les Casse Têtes and Limozin near Volnay, which give an added richness and intensity.

### Tasting Notes:

This is an excellent Meursault showing the distinct freshness and salinity of the 2024 vintage. It offers a complex, focused style with notes of lemon, ripe stone fruits, honeysuckle and a lovely salinity. Tighter and less tropical than a typical Michelot Meursault, it is almost Puligny-like in its balance and steeliness.

<b>Vinification</b>	Fermented in tank and barrel, the wine sees a variety of vessels: one third in 500-litre foudres (30% new), one third in 350-litre foudres (10% new), and one third in grès pots. It is aged in barrel for 12 months, followed by six months in tank.
