Beautifully perfumed and aromatic, this is a delectable light red wine – soft, velvety and fruity.

Tasting Notes:

Cool fermentation with low skin maceration, in order to ensure the right acidity and structure, and aging in old French oak casks. This wine shows a surprisingly light ruby colour, a fruity nose and a low alcohol content (12,5%) on the palate. Beautifully perfumed and aromatic with wild berry fruits and a little spice.
