A very small plot, just 0.18 hectare in size with an average age of vines of 61 years, situated to the right as you enter Pommard from Beaune, lying on vineyards that slope gently up from the road on the right as you leave Beaune, and adjoining Beaune 1er Cru.

### Tasting Notes:

The wine is deep in colour, with a ripe and expressive nose. On the palate, it is rich and explosive, smoky and dense yet balanced at every level. Layers of boiled red fruits mingle with brooding tannins and integrated sweet oak conveying remarkable power, depth, and concentration. A bright, lifting freshness keeps the wine poised whilst the long and lingering finish confirms its exceptional harmony and precision.
