This impressive and muscular Pinot comes from 4 plots totalling 1.2ha (Cras, Poisots, Saussilles and Vaumuriens) that lead down from the village along a gentle slope of red soil and clay that neighbours the 1er cru of Clos Blanc. The average age of the vines is 50-60 years.

Tasting Notes:

This is quite a difference from previous vintages, where Pommard can be a little 'chewy'. The 2023 is superbly fruit-forward, lush and decadent, a sweetness and fullness of mulled fruit shining through, yet the weight and structure of the tannins eventually grasp the fruit and give it edge and precision. Very, very good!
