This powerful red comes from 4 separate plots (Cras, Poisots, Saussilles and Vaumuriens) totalling 1.225 hectares, with the oldest vines planted in 1936. Situated on a gentle slope of red soil and clay bordering the Premier Cru of Clos Blanc, these vineyards produce big, opulent wines.

Tasting Notes:

The nose is deep, profound and expressive whilst the palate is rich, structured, and brooding, revealing layers of mulled black and red fruits and earthy notes. Firm, robust tannins give the wine structure, balanced by ripe, sweet fruit. The finish is long, powerful and almost flinty, with subtle oak sweetness adding weight. This is a wine built for age.
