Tasting Notes:

Light ruby colour. Smoky nose with fresh red fruits, raspberry and strawberry with a touch of spice. The palate is light and vibrant with good acidity, showing bright red fruit alongside savoury and slightly vegetal notes. Smooth, fine tannins provide gentle structure, leading to a fresh, clean finish.

It began with around 5 hectares of vines and has since grown to approximately 12 hectares. Based near Toulouse-le-Château, the domaine specialises in the main Jura grape varieties with an emphasis on low yields and precise vineyard work to express site and variety. Frederic's son Romain joined in 2020, continuing the family involvement, with his daughter Lucie expected to join in the future.
