This south-west facing, single 0.96 plot of vines was planted in 1990 on a steep slope to the east of the village of Saint-Romain towards Auxey-Duresses. The soil is predominantly white marl and limestone with some clay. This is one of our favourite wines from this domaine.

Tasting Notes:

The bouquet is bright with tropical fruit aromas leading to a zesty palate full of grapefruit and pineapple characters. There is a slaty minerality, a note of gunflint and a quenching finish that is long and infused with a touch of hazelnut.
