### Tasting Notes:

A dark colour, rich and appealing nose with a core of sweet boiled black fruits, some opulence and a distinct ripeness. In the mouth the wine continued with the opulent character – the core of sweet black fruits held with plush rounded tannins, some freshness and a well-defined, subtle oak veneer. There is texture aplenty here, with nice structure and grip on the long finish.

The family has a lovely spread of top vineyards in Savigny-lès-Beaune (both superb premier crus and a handful of top village wine parcels planted with very old pinot noir vines), as well as a bit of premier cru in Beaune and Pommard as well.
