This 1er Cru of just 0.6ha is situated to the eastern extremities of the appellation adjacent to Pommard on a chalk and powdery limestone subsoil. Produced from vines averaging 60-65 years old, planted between 1932 and 1978.

### Tasting Notes:

This scored very highly – very ripe, very forward, very intense – a richly structured and decadent Volnay, showing weight, supple yet tightening tannins, streaks of pureed black fruits, ironstone, spice and oak. The character is suave, generous and supple, yet there is a brooding sense of power within the finish. Concentrated and very long on the finish.
