Jean Pierre Charlot, son-in-law of the founder Joseph Voillot, has now passed on the running of the family domaine to his nephew, Etienne Chaix. This exceptional domaine's future is now secure. The domaine consists of 9ha of vineyards, including some prized sites in several 1er Crus. The grapes are partially destemmed and the wines matured in oak barrels (15-20% new) for 14-16 months. Without doubt one of the finest domaines in Volnay, these wines are never heavy or over extracted. They offer the fragrance, charm and beauty so typical of Volnay. "I am very satisfied with this vintage!" said Etienne Chaix with a mischievous grin. A true master of the understatement!

Tasting Notes:

Produced from 8 plots totaling just under 2ha, the 'vieilles vignes' average over 40 years old. With only one new barrel used this means slightly less than 5% new oak in the cuvee. This is such a suave wine, with black fruit aromas and a palate of fresh black cherries providing a charming elegance. The tannins are succulent and support the wine beautifully whilst a hint of spice and hedgerow on the finish provides added dimension.
